

Guidelines for Your Enjoyment and Safety

In order to make your stay and the stay of our other guests a great experience, please observe the following friendly camping practices:

- All campers and visitors must register at the office before entering. Check-out time is 11 a.m. Please check out at the campground office when leaving. All day visitors must leave the campground by 10 p.m.
- No refund for early departure.
- Speed limit throughout the campground is 5 mph. Please watch for pedestrians, bicyclists, ATVs and motorcycles.
- Quiet hours are from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. Noise should be kept to a minimum during this time. Please respect your neighbors.
- The Bathhouse has four family-friendly showers. Children must be accompanied by an adult while in the Bathhouse -- this includes laundry and vending areas.
- Cabins are non-smoking. Charges will be added to your credit card upon check-out for the cleaning of linens, curtains and furniture up to \$250 if you violate this policy.
- No muddy boots inside the cabins. No muddy clothing on the furniture and beds.
- We are a pet friendly place, but pets must be on a short leash and must be cleaned up after at all times. No more than two pets allowed per site. Please do not leave your pet unattended. Pets are not allowed in the Bathhouse. An additional cleaning fee of \$50 will apply if your pet is housed in the cabins.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in common areas.
- Please do not park on the grass or on vacant campsites or in vacant RV sites. We have folks with reservations coming in after hours sometimes and you may inadvertently be parking in their spot. Use roadways to travel to and from your campsite. Two vehicles are allowed per site. If space is needed for extra vehicles, overflow parking is available.
- No clotheslines may be strung outside.
- Washing vehicles/RVs/ATVs/UTVs/Motorcycles/Bikes or mechanical repairs to them, including changing the oil, is prohibited on site.
- It is against state law to dump grey water or sewage on the ground. It is to be disposed of at the dump station on site as shown on the campground map.
- An airtight hose connection is required for sewer hook-up of RVs.
- Generators of any kind are prohibited.
- Trash cans are distributed throughout the campground – please use them. Cigarette butts are litter, please use appropriate disposal containers. A dumpster is located near the visitor center. Please use it for bagged trash.
- Campfires are permitted, but only in established fire rings. It is not permitted to move fire rings. Never leave a fire unattended. Children under the age of 18 cannot have a fire unless an adult is present.
- Firearms, lethal weapons, fireworks, slingshots, pellet or BB guns are PROHIBITED.

The owner or management of Southern Gap Outdoor Adventure is not responsible for loss, damage or claims for damage to property of campers due to fire, theft, accidents or other causes. Disregard for any of the above rules will be sufficient reason to terminate a guest's stay without refund. Management reserves the right to change these rules as circumstances require.
